All these amazing people have raised funds for the VSF in the last 4 months!






Successful Heart Screenings

Did you know that in the last 7 days at least 12 apparently fit and healthy young people aged 35 and under have collapsed and died from an undiagnosed heart condition? *source—Cardiac Risk in the Young (CRY)


In the time you have read this, another young person will have collapsed and died from a Sudden Cardiac Arrest and another family's life will be changed forever!

Please help the VSF raise funds to provide more FREE heart screenings? The next young death could be your son, daughter, friend or work colleague!

Since our last newsletter in early September, this is what's been happening with our FREE heart screenings.



Anthony James Estate Agents with Scarisbrick Hall School's PFA sponsored a very successful heart screening on Saturday 19th September 2015. We screened 79 young people on the day and of those, 15 were referred for further investigation.
