
Hemby Charitable Trust awarded us a grant of £2000 - we can now start to purchase our own screening equipment.

## Successful Heart Screenings

To date we have screened over 1300 people!
Since our last newsletter, this is what's been happening with our FREE heart screenings.



We held a FREE heart screening at Overchurch Primary School, Upton on Saturday 21st January 2017. This screening was sponsored by Upton Cricket Club who chose us as their Charity of the Year We screened 72 young people on the day and had 1 person referred to Liverpool Heart and Chest Hospital for further tests.

On Sunday 12th March we delivered another FREE Heart Screening in memory of Crosby resident, Chris Tansey at Garston Urban Village Hall in South Liverpool.

77 young people aged between 15 – 35 were screened and 1 person was referred for further tests.



In the time you have read this, another young person will have collapsed and died from a Sudden Cardiac Arrest and another family's life will be changed forever!

Please help the VSF raise funds to provide more FREE heart screenings.

The next young death could be your son, daughter, friend or work colleague!
